COOLING-OFF PERIOD

Further, the net amount of payment or delivery due the TRUSTOR shall be based on the transaction day's NAVPU when notice of redemption, termination or cancellation was received.

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Investor Fund intends to achieve for its participants long-term capital growth by investing in a diversified portfolio of US Dollar-denominated collective investment schemes. The Investor Fund will have more than one (1) Target Funds at any given time. The Target Funds may be changed from time-to-time subject to regulations and the stipulations contained in the Declaration of Trust.

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process is performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are encouraged to update the resulting profile every three (3) years or if there's any change in his/her personal/financial circumstances. Before deciding to invest, clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, or seek an independent/professional opinion when necessary.

The METRO MULTI-THEMED EQUITY FUND OF FUNDS is suitable only for investors who:

- Have an Aggressive profile.
- Want capital appreciation over the long-term by investing in more than one Target Funds at any given time.
- Recommended investment horizon is at least five (5) years
- Participation in the Investor Fund shall be open to Filipino individuals, resident and non-resident aliens and domestic corporate accounts. However, persons from United States of America (USA), Canada, India, and People's Republic of China are not qualified to open an account.

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

Market/Price Risk:	The possibility for an investor to experience losses due to changes in the market prices of stocks/equities. It refers to the portfolio's exposure to marked-to-market valuation due to market price fluctuations of the stocks/equities.
Liquidity Risk:	The possibility for an investor to experience losses due to the inability to sell or convert assets into cash immediately or in instances where conversion to cash is possible but at a price that could result in a loss. This may be caused by low trading volume due to different reasons such as securities with small or few outstanding issues, absence of buyers and/or sellers (limited buy/sell activity) or underdeveloped capital market.

The foreign currency position of the Investor will not be hedged.
Country Risk:	The possibility for an investor to experience losses arising from investments in securities issued by/in foreign countries due to the political, economic and social structures of these countries. There are risks in foreign investments due to the possible internal and external conflicts, currency devaluations, foreign ownership limitations and tax increases of the foreign country involved which are difficult to predict but must be taken into account in making such investments.
Other Risks:	Your participation in the UITFs may be further exposed to the risk of any actual or potential conflicts of interest in the handling of in-house or related party transactions by Metrobank. 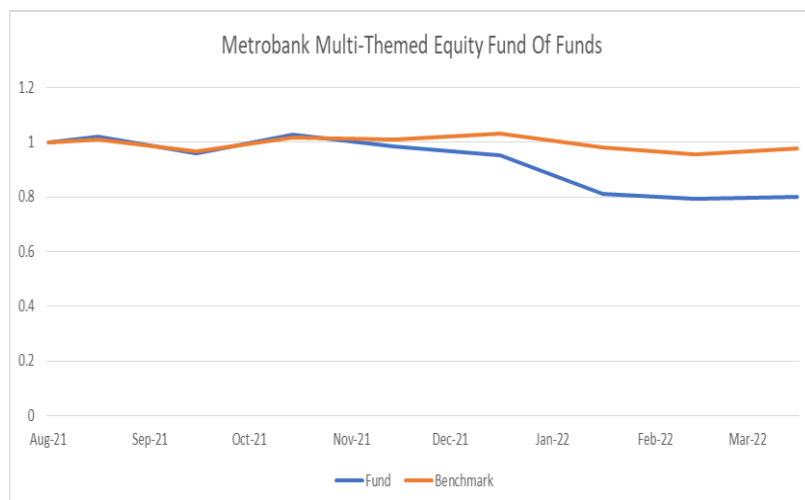

INVESTMENT POLICY

A. The Investor Fund may be invested and reinvested in the following instruments:

- USD-denominated units/shares in more than one collective investment schemes subject to the conditions under BSP Circular 767
- USD-denominated money market instruments
- USD/PHP-denominated deposits
- Other USD-denominated Investments allowed under BSP regulations

B. The Target Fund may be invested and reinvested in the following instruments:

- Global-denominated Investments allowed under regulations issued by the Bangko Sentral Ng Pilipinas;
- Global-denominated Exchange-listed securities;
- Global-denominated deposits with local banks/foreign banks
- Financial derivative instruments for hedging purposes and efficient portfolio management.

C. The Investor Fund may invest a minimum of 90% of its net asset value in more than one (1) Target Fund and a maximum of 10% in cash, deposits and other money market instruments

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

The fund posted a 1.24% gain in March, underperforming MSCI All Country World +2.17%. This brings the fund's year-to-date performance to -15.97% vs. benchmark's -5.36%.

Global equity markets have come under pressure due to the inflationary uncertainties brought about by the ongoing conflict between Russia and Ukraine. In view of this, major central banks are off to raising interest rates, albeit at a faster pace, as inflation runs hot to multi-decade highs. The US Federal Reserve has finally raised its policy rates by 25 bps from near zero – the first hike since 2018. Investors are already pricing in 200 bps increase in policy rates for 2022. The Bank of England (BoE) raised their policy rates three times since December 2021 and now stands at 0.75% while the European Central Bank (ECB) was relatively dovish with its “gradually and flexibly” stance in its monetary approach. Overall, looming energy crisis brought by the war in Eastern Europe has proven that price stability mandate to be a tall order for central banks.

With the heightened fears of recession, we expect volatility to persist with the yield curve flattening and in some cases, reaching short-term inversion. Rising costs have weighed on general consumers' purchasing power especially in the US where household spending accounts for roughly 70% of Gross Domestic Product (GDP). Mortgage rates and home prices are quickly rising to multi-year highs. Supply-chain measures remain tight across industries. Elevated inflation, rising interest rates and bleak growth outlook have downgraded company valuations with growth companies underperforming the most as profit projections become more vulnerable.

The Philippine peso depreciated against the US Dollar closing 1Q at 51.74 (+47c higher MoM, +0.92%) and the pair reached a high of 52.495 mid-month. The country's Gross International Reserves have fallen to USD 107.98Bn compared to last month's USD 107.69 Bn, roughly 10.2 months' worth of import cover.

The first quarter of the year faced numerous headwinds sending markets in a tailspin. The fund continues to exercise maximum defensive measures to shelter against short-term volatility including the move to cash. Despite these, our confidence in the themes remains unshaken and we believe it will remain relevant in the long-term.
