INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE AND STRATEGY

The Investor Fund is a USD-denominated equity Unit Investment Trust Fund structured as a feeder fund and aims to provide market returns from a representative portfolio of stocks that comprise the China Equity Market by investing at least 90% of its assets in the iShares MSCI China A UCITS ETF USD.

The Fund's benchmark is the MSCI China A Inclusion Net Return USD Index (M1CNA).

CLIENT SUITABILITY

A client profiling process is performed prior to participating in the Fund to guide the prospective investor if the Fund is suited to his/her investment objectives and risk tolerance. Clients are encouraged to update the resulting profile every three (3) years or if there's any change in his/her personal/financial circumstances. Before deciding to invest, clients are advised to read the Declaration of Trust/Plan Rules of the Fund, which may be obtained from the Trustee, or seek an independent/professional opinion when necessary.

The METRO\$ CHINA EQUITY FEEDER FUND is suitable only for investors who:

- Have an Aggressive profile.
- Want capital appreciation over the long-term by primarily investing in iShares MSCI China A UCITS ETF USD.
- Recommended investment horizon is at least five (5) years
- Participation in the Investor Fund shall be open to Filipino individuals, resident and non-resident aliens, and corporate accounts. However, persons from US, and Canada are not allowed to open an account.

KEY RISKS AND RISK MANAGEMENT

You should not invest in this Fund if you do not understand or are not comfortable with the accompanying risks.

Market/Price Risk:	The possibility for an investor to experience losses due to changes in the market prices of stocks/equities. It refers to the portfolio's exposure to marked-to-market valuation due to market price fluctuations of the stocks/equities.

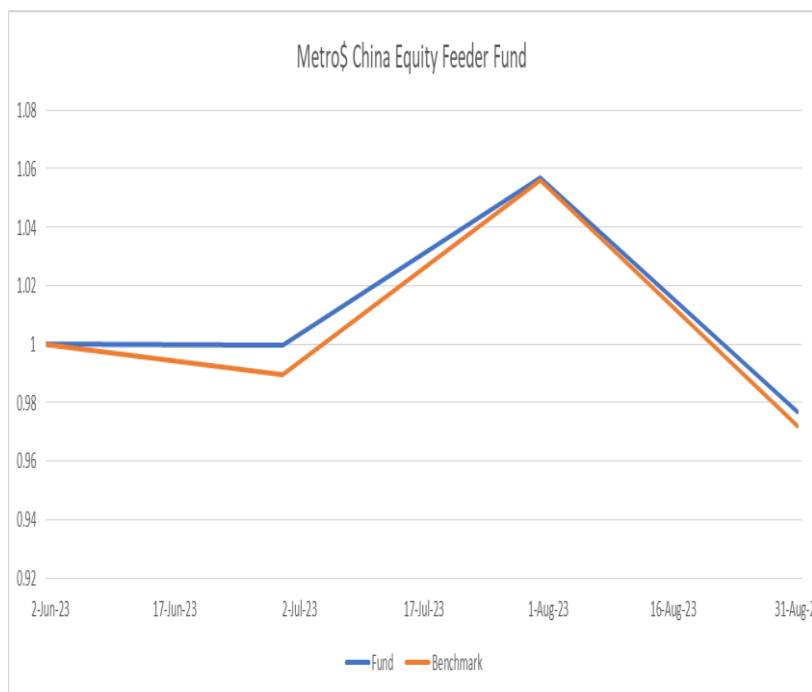

⁴ Information Ratio measures reward-to-risk efficiency of the portfolio relative to the benchmark. The higher the number, the higher the reward per unit of risk.

⁵ Tracking Error measures the deviation between the Fund's return and benchmark return since the Fund's inception. The lower the number, the more aligned the Fund's return is with the benchmark. (Starting September 2021 report the basis for the Tracking Error computation is since the Fund's inception.)

INVESTMENT POLICY

A. The Investor Fund may be invested and reinvested in the following instruments:

- USD-denominated units/shares in more than one collective investment schemes subject to the conditions under BSP Circular 767
- USD-denominated money market instruments
- USD/PHP-denominated deposits
- Other USD-denominated Investments allowed under BSP regulations

B. The Target Fund may be invested and reinvested in the following instruments:

- Global-denominated Investments allowed under regulations issued by the Bangko Sentral Ng Pilipinas;
- Global-denominated Exchange-listed securities;
- Global-denominated deposits with local banks/foreign banks
- Financial derivative instruments for hedging purposes and efficient portfolio management.

C. The Investor Fund may invest a minimum of 90% of its net asset value in more than one (1) Target Fund and a maximum of 10% in cash, deposits and other money market instruments

OUTLOOK AND STRATEGY

The fund decreased by 7.58% for the month, better than the target fund's decrease of 8.11%. The fund's outperformance was due to the cash portion of the portfolio. Chinese markets are expected to remain volatile amid uncertain macro-economic backdrop. The fund is expected to keep cash elevated. China is expected to be a laggard to the U.S. and Japan.

Once again, China's property sector takes the spotlight as debt and liquidity issues resurface for struggling developers. Declining sales and rising refinancing costs have led Country Garden, one of the country's property developers, to miss interest payments. This sector's troubles prompted the People's Bank of China (PBOC) to reduce the medium-term lending facility rate by 15 basis points to 2.5% in a bid to prevent contagion, boost demand, and curb investment outflows.

In addition to the property market challenges, both consumer and producer prices have fallen, underscoring weak demand across the economy. Unemployment has also increased slightly from 5.2% to 5.3%, with the Chinese government withholding the release of youth unemployment data to reduce negative catalysts. Overall, China is experiencing disinflation, as the year-on-year Consumer Price Index (CPI) has decreased by 0.3%, down from a previous reading of 0%.

It's noteworthy that in various economies, manufacturing has underperformed compared to services, suggesting that cash flow is currently favoring short-term spending over long-term investments. As China serves as the world's manufacturing hub, its Purchasing Managers Index (PMI) for manufacturing re-entering contraction territory could signal the possibility of global disinflation in the upcoming quarters.

China's July rally quickly faded as global markets turned risk-off in August, influenced by a more hawkish Federal Reserve stance. The previously discussed "higher for longer" narrative is gradually becoming a reality as the U.S. economy continues to display resilience to the Fed's aggressive monetary tightening. The DXY Index (dollar index) surged from 101.855 to 103.619, coinciding with bond yields reaching their highest levels since 2007.

China's concerns related to its property market, manufacturing sector, and unemployment have made it a prime target for capital outflows. Technical indicators for China's markets remain bearish across the board, and the nation is poised to retest its lockdown lows.
